The Fellowship Is Ready For Convention!

The site of the 2002 SAA Convention is one of America's favorite cities, and will host the Internnational affair from May 24 to May 27, 2002. United Airlines and Southwest Airlines are offering discounts on all air fares. The hotel will provide free shuttle service from and to the airport. While at the hotel, you also will have an opportunity to take advantage of many of the hotel's outstanding features, such as the swimming pool and workout facility. You may want to relax in the hotel's spacious, lush atrium, or hop aboard a train (the station is a block from the hotel) and go into downtown.
