Supports SAA members and groups

- Refers newcomers to SAA meetings
 - Answers phone calls, emails, texts, and letters
 - Guides, supports, and registers new meetings
 - Updates the meeting database and maintains the online meeting search
 - Provides support lists for women, men, and LGBT members
 - Coordinates the annual ISO convention

Publishes literature

- Maintains an online store offering SAA literature, convention audios, sobriety chips, and more
 - Supports the author's group in developing SAA literature
 - Works with distributors to make SAA literature available in multiple outlets, within the US and internationally
 - Registers SAA trademarks and copyrights SAA literature
 - Coordinates translations of SAA literature

Assists prisoners

- Coordinates prisoner sponsorship program
 - Handles responses to 200 prisoner letters per month
 - Ships free literature to prisons and prisoners
 - Educates prison officials about SAA
